

"30 hours of lectures a week, approximately 30 hours of independent work, and then 60 more in theological discussion with each other – that's what you can expect a normal week to be like. You can sleep when you're done with seminary." So President Godeke von Bremen jokingly began his talk with the students at the beginning of the new trimester, which runs from September 27th to December 17th.

The most important and most delighting part of the new trimester is the fact that 5 new students, young men and women from the Kyrgyz Republic, Kazakhstan and European Russia, have joined us. Since they in general already have good education background in theology, they will study with the students who last year went through a preparatory course. The trimester began with a worship service with Holy Communion, which was led by the Seminary President together with the students from the 3rd course.

In front of these 15 students (total) lie lively decisions including talks about their summer internships, as well as intensive studies and exercises for a fruitful spiritual life.
